Before submitting a full piece, please send a **150-word synopsis** to liz@farmingfirst.org that includes:

- The name and title of the author of the blog
- A catchy headline
- Three to five bullet points that outline your article
- Any connection to news events, report launches etc (if relevant)

Remember! We are looking for your unique perspective as a young person, so make sure you refer to any youth movements or projects you might be involved in, for example:

- What are the challenges and opportunities facing young people in agriculture?
- What kind of support do young people need to realize their work?
- Do you know any young people making a big impact in the area you are writing about?

March

Deadline for submission of interest: 1st February 2015

Focus: International Women's Day

<u>Brief:</u> Are you, or_have you met a successful female entrepreneur who is running successful agribusinesses in the developing world? What have they needed in order to succeed? What impact has their business had on their local community?

May

Deadline for submission of interest: 1st April 2015

Focus: International Year of Soils

<u>Brief:</u> Why has soil health crept up the food security agenda? Are you a young soil scientist working on a new innovation? What impact can better soil health have? What role does efficient use of fertilizer play?

July

Deadline for submission of interest: 1st June 2015

Focus: Post-2015

<u>Brief:</u> Are you working on project relating to the formation of the Sustainable Development Goals? How is it progressing and what challenges has it faced? How can young people play a more active role in the execution of the Sustainable Development Goals?

September

Deadline for submission of interest: 1st August 2015

Focus: World Water Week

<u>Brief:</u> Agriculture's use of the world's water reserves is larger than any other sector. Are you working on an innovative project for more sustainable and efficient water use? Have you witnessed it working in the developing world? Can you illustrate this story through a photo gallery?

November

Deadline for submission of interest: 1st October 2015

Focus: Climate Change

<u>Brief:</u> Have you recently begun working in an organisation that deals with agriculture and climate issues? Tell us about your experience working in such an organisation, and how it is helping to drive agriculture up the climate change agenda.
